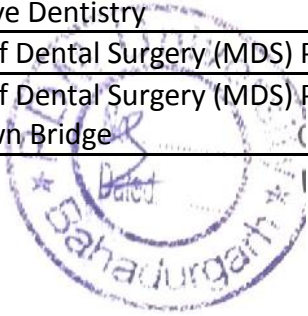

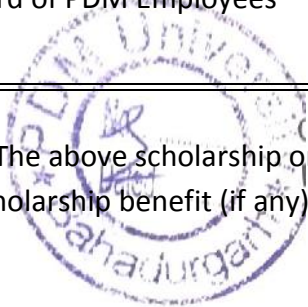

**Fee Structure:**

1. The university may, from time to time, prepare fee structure and shall send it for information to the Government, at least thirty days before the commencement of the academic session.
2. The fee structure for the twenty-five percent of the students who are domicile of Haryana shall be based on merit-cum-means and be as follows:-
  - a. One-fifth of the twenty-five percent shall be granted full fee concession
  - b. Two-fifth of the twenty-five percent shall be granted fifty percent fee concession.
  - c. The balance two-fifth of the twenty-five percent shall be granted twenty-five percent fee concession.\*  
Provided that in case of the Universities having collaboration with reputed foreign or international universities or other institutions of other similar nature, the Government may approve different percentage of students eligible for 100%, 50% or 25% fee concession.~
3. The university shall not charge any fee, by whatever name called, other than that prescribed as per sub-sections (1) and (2) above.”
