# Bachelor of Fine Arts CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

#### STUDENTS LEARNING OUTCOMES

The curriculum and syllabi of Bachelor of Fine Arts program (2018-19) conform to Outcome Based Education (OBE) for a flexible and structured Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). In general, **ELEVEN STUDENT OUTCOMES** (a-k) have been identified and the curriculum and syllabi have been chosen in such a way that each of the modules meets one or more of these outcomes. Student outcomes describe what students are expected to know and be able to do by the time of graduation. These relate to the skills, knowledge, and behaviors that students acquire as they progress through the program. Further, each module in the program spells out clear instructional objectives which are mapped to the student outcomes.

#### The Student Outcomes are:

- (a) Ability to demonstrate familiarity with established knowledge in the field of Applied Arts and awareness of current development therein.
- (b) Ability to demonstrate critical thinking through analysis and evaluation of works of art.
- (c) Ability to engage in independent and contextually-informed artistic practice.
- (d) Ability to understand the function of presentation and/or the exhibition process of personal works in public gallery or other cultural venue.
- (e) Ability to apply basic managerial and entrepreneurial skills in Applied Arts field.
- (f) Students will demonstrate a proficiency of techniques, knowledge of vocabulary, and an exploration of various media.
- (g) Able to understand theatre as a collaborative art form with social impact.
- (h) Ability to acquire a practical understanding of the processes of rehearsing, performing, in live and filmed/recorded media.
- (i) An understanding of professional and ethical values.
- (j) Ability to communicate effectively in diverse groups and exhibit leadership skills.
- (k) To develop an understanding of global environment and its protection.
